Tour A: Glendalough and Powerscourt House and Gardens

Your first stop will be **Glendalough Visitor's Centre** where you will see the Audio Visual presentation followed by a tour of this early Christian monastic site, founded by St. Kevin in the 6th century. Set in a glaciated valley with two lakes, the monastic remains include a superb round tower, stone churches and decorated crosses.

Learn about the "sport of kings" and view some of Ireland's finest thoroughbred horses at the **Irish National Stud;** the Stud combines an active role in the development and promotion of Irish bloodstock with its role as one of the country's major tourist attractions. It is the only Stud farm in Ireland open to the public.

On the same grounds, visit the **Japanese Gardens**, acclaimed as the finest Japanese gardens in Europe. They are a living monument to the meeting of Eastern and Western cultures in a Western setting. The aim of the Japanese Gardens was, through trees, plants, flowers, lawns, rocks and water, to symbolize the "Life of Man". The Japanese Gardens are a place for contemplation, meditation and reflection.

Lunch on own.

Continue to **Malahide Castle**, one of the oldest and most historic castles in Ireland. From 1185 to 1975, it was the home of the Talbot family. This was a remarkable tenure by a single family and is one of the longest in Ireland.
